Lobster Trap Clean-Up Day is Coming!

On May 7th, local residents will descend on local beaches and clear away debris washed in during winter storms. Besides the aluminum cans, plastic grocery bags and other trash, volunteers and lobstermen will be gathering lobster traps and returning them to the owner. Gear is expensive and our local guys are always glad to recover lost equipment and return it to service. So come out and get some fresh air and exercise while you contribute to a clean Kittery. Say hi to a lobsterman!

Engineering and permitting work will begin shortly for the planned improvements to the Fishermen's pier. The Port Authority and Town received the Federal grant from US Fish and Wildlife for \$242,000 to help pay for improvements to recreational and transient boating facilities at the cove. Both projects will contribute to the long term viability of Pepperrell Cove for all users.

Mooring renewals are nearly complete and soon we will do the temporary assignments for this season. Anyone who has not contacted me for their mooring renewal needs to do so before April 15th in order to avoid the \$50 late fee.
