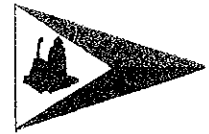


BOATING SAFETY CERTIFICATION CLASS



US Power Squadrons America's Boating Course 3



The Portsmouth Sail and Power Squadron, a unit of the United States Power Squadrons, is offering the America's Boating Course 3, in 8 sessions beginning on:

Tuesday January 26, 2010, and ending Tuesday March 23, 2010

at the Portsmouth High School Cafeteria, Portsmouth, NH.
There will be eight two hour classes. Classes start at 7:00 PM.

Course Fee is \$50

This is a comprehensive study of Boating Operation and Safety, which meets all requirements of the National Association of State Boating Law Administrators (NASBLA) *nationwide*. This course satisfies the State of New Hampshire's requirement, that ALL BOATERS operating any boat with an engine of over 25 horsepower, in New Hampshire waters, must be certified as having successfully completed a recognized boating safety course of study, and have, on their person, evidence of such completion. It should be noted that New Hampshire Boating Safety Law applies to ALL BOAT OPERATORS from any state, not just New Hampshire residents.

The America's Boating Course 3 covers Safe Operation, Seamanship and Boat Handling, Charts, Navigation and Piloting, Government Rules and Requirements, Navigation Rules, Trailing, VHF Radio and the Global Positioning System.

Upon successful completion of the course, and passing the examination, boaters will be certified, and entitled to the Power Squadron's Certificate of Completion, and the State of New Hampshire's Certificate, both of which are accepted by all States having Boating Safety Laws.

At the present time, the State of Maine does not require a Boating Safety Certificate, but legislation is in process to set up such a requirement in Maine. Maine, as of this year, does require that all Personal Watercraft Operators take and pass a prescribed Safety Course.

New Hampshire's Law applies to Maine boaters in New Hampshire waters.
