### JULY 7th '60s INVASION-Concert Begins at 7:00pm

New England's premiere sixties band performs a concert program of music from the 1960's. Set one will include a variety of songs, including music by the *Monkeys*, *Ventures*, *the Rascals*, and a special *Elvis Tribute*. The second set will include many more familiar songs and also a special segment called "*The History of Rock and Roll*." The segment includes trivia, facts rarely heard about the music, and in true *Sixties Invasion* style, plenty of humor. There will also be music by the Beatles.
